Application Process & Interview

To qualify for a place on our Trinity CertTESOL course, you'll need to complete our application process and attend an interview. We've provided more details about this process below:

- 1 First you should complete our online application form, where you'll need to provide details about your work and education background and why you want to do the course. At this point you'll pay your deposit and submit your ID and qualifications (in line with the entry requirements*).
- 2 Once this is complete, you'll be contacted by the Course Director in order to arrange a 90-minute Zoom interview. The interview will include a 'live' writing task, assessment of your spoken English, assessment of your ability to perform under pressure, and a discussion about your approach to teaching and education.
- 3 Once the interview stage is passed, you have achieved a place on the course! This will be confirmed by the Course Director and you will receive a Pre-Course Task (workbook) and be provided with access to selected sections of the course (the Welcome page, Handbook, timetable, and policies) via our online platform.
- 4 The final stage is receiving the start date for your course and, once this is reached, you can start studying!

* Entry requirements: Trinity state that these must be 'qualifications for entry to higher education in the UK or in the trainees' home country', e.g. Level 3 qualifications equivalent to 2 or more A levels.
